This year the fun will begin even before ride day with a pre-party and packet pickup the evening prior, giving participants a chance to mingle, connect with fellow riders, and kick off the weekend in a relaxed, festive atmosphere. After the ride, the celebration continues at the popular after-party featuring free DAM J.A.M. custom beer, delicious burgers, and music that brings riders together to celebrate the journey. From start to finish, DAM J.A.M. delivers a high-energy, unforgettable experience that keeps cyclists coming back year after year.

The IMPACT Network program works to encourage healthier lifestyles by promoting tobacco cessation, physical activity, and improved nutrition. Efforts include supporting local policies that reduce tobacco/vape use, assisting communities with park and trail enhancements, and promoting active transportation programs. The program also expands access to healthy foods through partnerships with farmers markets, restaurants, and local organizations while offering resources and education.



The All Things Green Program promotes sustainability, nutrition, and gardening education while supporting local food-insecurity efforts. Through the Pryor Creek Community Garden, volunteers and students help grow and donate fresh produce, with over 900 pounds shared last season. The garden also serves as an outdoor classroom, where children learn about healthy eating, gardening basics, and STEM concepts through hands-on lessons that build skills and encourage giving back to their community.



The HOPE4Youth program empowers youth to develop healthy habits, prevent substance abuse, and provides education on a variety of important youth issues, all with the goal of fostering a healthier, safer community. Through their involvement, students gain valuable leadership experience, teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills, tools that prepare them for success in future educational, civic, and workforce opportunities.
