

Frequently Asked Questions



Q: What does HOPE do?

A: The HOPE Coalition brings together community resources in order to inspire Healthy lifestyles through Outreach, Prevention & Education. Our mission is to make Mayes County a healthier place to live, work, and play.

Q: What if I want to support HOPE, but do not want to compete?

A: You can be an event sponsor! For \$300, your company's logo will be displayed on our website & at the event of your choice. This is a great way to promote your company visually, whether participating or just being a spectator!

Q: How many people do I need on my team?

A: As long as you have enough people to participate in each event (refer to *delegation list*), then it does not matter how many people are on your team. However, keep in mind that there are at least *one to two women* needed for several events.

Q: Can I recruit people that do not belong to my business/organization to compete on my team?

A: Spouses & children (17+ and max of 3) of the employees/members are the *only* people eligible to join your team.

Q: Does my team have to participate in every event?

A: Yes, including the Opening Ceremony! However, not every team member will participate in every event.

Q: Does my team have to have T-shirts made?

A: This is not required, but part of the fun! We encourage each team to participate in the T-shirt Competition, & they will receive 20 *bonus* points for submission. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners will win even more points!

Q: How can I get bonus points?

A: There are four ways a team can receive bonus points.

1. Bike Executive Granny Panty Race: Refer to rules. **20 pts for each team that participates. More for winner!**
2. T-Shirt Competition: Refer to Team Captain Info. **20 pts for submission. 1st, 2nd, 3rd place will get even more!**
3. Volunteers: Must be an employee/member, spouse or child (17+). **1 pt per volunteer (max 5 team pts)**

Q: What is Tent City?

A: Consider Tent City your team's dugout. Your team can congregate here for direction, shade, company provided refreshments, etc. Each business/organization will bring their own 10x10 tent for a space in Tent City.

Q: Is Tent City required?

A: It is not required, but keep in mind that it was included in your sponsorship. We strongly encourage you to take advantage of the space for your team and fans.
